

#### Athlete eligibility

Athletes must have signed and submitted the Athlete Eligibility Condition Form.

All athletes must have been born on **December 31, 2004**, at the latest and must hold a current UCI License issued by their corresponding National Federation. According to the UCI regulations for Track Cycling events, athletes born until December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2005 (second year Junior category) may participate. This quota cannot be used for the road events.

As host country, Chile automatically qualifies with 24 quotas (12 men and 12 women). As Chile will have the maximum quota allowed, it must participate in all team events.


The countries that qualify in teams are not entitled to qualify additional quotas for individual events, but they may compete in the individual events of the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games.

The countries are obligated to participate in the events that they qualified for.

Track athletes can compete in Road events and vice versa, as long as the maximum quotas per NOC and per event are respected.

MTB athletes may compete in the Road events, as long as the maximum quotas per NOC and per event are respected.

The NOCs must inform the list of athletes who will compete in a discipline that is different from the one that they qualified for. This list must be sent before July 20, 2023, to the following emails: presidencia@copaci.org and andrea@panamsports.org







#### **Confirmation of quota places**

The COPACI will confirm to Panam Sports and to the NOCs the places that have qualified no later than July 10, 2023.

The NOCs will confirm to Panam Sports and to COPACI the places they will use no later than July 15, 2023.

#### **Reallocation of unused quota places**

If necessary, the COPACI will reallocate unused quota places to the next best positioned NOC before July 16, 2023.

The NOCs that receive reallocated quotas must confirm their acceptance to COPACI no later than July 19, 2023.

#### **Qualification for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games**

In Cycling, the athletes will obtain points for the Olympic qualification ranking according to the table of scales of UCI Points for Continental Games.
