# Athlete eligibility

The athletes must have signed and submitted the Athlete Eligibility Condition Form.

The athletes must sign and submit the proper eligibility forms of the International Hockey Federation (FIH).

## **Qualification system**

As host country, Chile will automatically qualify.

The remaining teams will qualify through the following competitions:

#### \*Updated text (redaction)\*

- 1. Host country Santiago, Chile
- 2. The two (2) countries ranked at first and second places at the South American (ODESUR) Games 2022, Asuncion, Paraguay;
- 3. The two (2) countries ranked first and second places at the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games 2023, City TBD;
- 4. The next two (2) countries not already qualified under paragraphs 1-3 above, based on final rankings at the VI Pan American Cup 2021(played in January 2022 because the COVID);
- 5. If the Host country, Chile is also ranked first or second in the South American (ODESUR) Games 2022, then a third team not yet qualified based on final rankings at the VI Pan American Cup 2021 will qualify.
- 6. For both men and women tournaments, if United States and/or Canada are not already qualified under paragraphs 1 to 5 above, they will engage in a play-off competition between themselves and the next ranked team not yet qualified based on final rankings at the VI Pan American Cup 2021, provided that team is ranked higher than either CAN and/or the U.S.A.. The date and site for this completion will be determined by the PAHF.
- 7. The two (2) reserve teams will be the losers of the playoff competition referred in the paragraph 6 above. If the United States and Canada are already qualified, the next better positions country in the VI Pan American Cup 2021 / Pan American Challenge 2019 will be named as reserve(s).

#### Notes:

- a) If there are less than four participants in either the South American (ODESUR) Games 2022 or the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games 2022, an additional country will qualify based on the final rankings of the VI Pan American Cups 2021.
- b) If USA and CAN are qualified under paragraphs 1-4, the eight qualified team will be the next placed country of the VI Pan American Cups 2021.
- c) If the play-off competition referred at paragraph 6 above arises, all costs for participating in the same are to be borne by the respective national Associations. The PAHF will be responsible for covering the cost of neutral officials for such competition.







# **Confirmation of quota places**

The PAHF will confirm to Panam Sports and to the NOCs the places they have qualified before July 10, 2023.

The NOCs will confirm to Panam Sports and to the PAHF the places they will use before July 14, 2023.

# Reallocation of unused quota places

If necessary, the PAHF will reallocate unused quota places to the next best ranked NOC that has not qualified by July 17, 2023.

The NOCs that receive reallocated quotas must confirm their participation no later than on July 19, 2023.

### **Qualification for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games**

The winning teams of each gender will obtain direct qualification for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games.
