## Athlete eligibility

The athletes must have signed and submitted the Athlete Eligibility Condition Form. All participating athletes must have been born in 2008 at the latest

To participate in the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games each athlete must fulfill the rules established by Panam Sports, as well as the regulations of the International Judo Federation / Pan American Judo Confederation. The National Federation and the athletes must have a valid affiliation to the Pan American Judo Confederation and [the International Judo Federation](#). The athlete must be registered by his/her NOC using the registration system for the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games.

If an athlete who qualified at the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games for a weight category does not participate in said category in the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games, the quota will be lost and cannot be transferred to another NOC or athlete. If the athlete changes category he/she must earn a new spot through the Santiago 2023 qualification system within the maximum quota per NOC.

An athlete who qualified at the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games cannot earn another quota for his/her NOC for the same weight category in which he/she qualified; however, another athlete can compete in the same weight category to earn another quota through the Santiago 2023 qualification system within the maximum quota per NOC.



## Qualification system

1. 09 first places of the Pan American ranking per each weight category.
2. 01 quota per weight category directly allocated to the host country.
3. 01 quota per each weight category directly allocated to the gold medal winners in the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games.
4. A maximum of one athlete per country for each weight category among the athletes who qualified according to points 1 and 2.
5. The score is of the athlete and will not leave a place for the country (in case he/she does not compete).
6. The four (04) best scores obtained in qualification events will be considered as a maximum.
7. If two or more athletes have the same scores in the ranking, said ranking will be determined as follows:
  - a. The athlete who within his/her 4 best scores in qualification events has the largest number of points obtained in [Lima 2022 Pan American Championship and the Guayaquil 2023 Pan American Open](#);
  - b. If a tie prevails, the athlete who within his/her 4 best scores in qualification events has the largest number of points obtained in Pan American Opens ([except for the Guayaquil 2023 Pan American Open](#));
  - c. If the tie prevails, the largest number of points in an event will be considered and then, if required, the second largest number of points will be considered, and so on.

If athletes are still tied, the Executive Board of the Pan American Judo Confederation will make the decision.

### **Confirmation of quota places**

The NOCs must submit their entry by number on the established date (July 20, 2023).

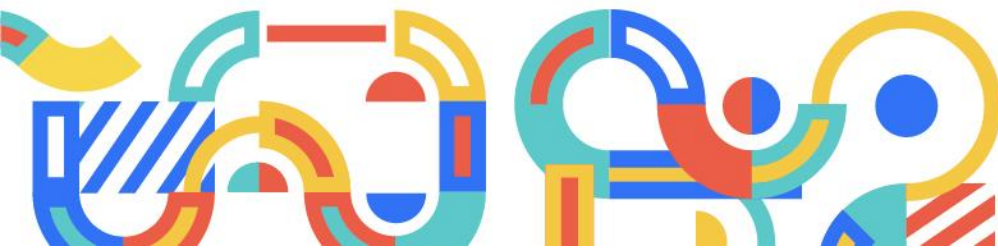
The Pan American Judo Confederation will confirm to Panam Sports and to the NOCs the places that each NOC has qualified no later than **July 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2023**.

The NOCs will confirm to Panam Sports and the Judo Pan American Confederation the places they will use no later than **July 26<sup>th</sup>, 2023**.

### **Reallocation of unused quota places**

If necessary, the Pan American Judo Confederation will reallocate unused places to the next best positioned NOC that has not yet qualified **no later than July 27<sup>th</sup>, 2023**.

NOCs that received reallocated quotas should confirm their participation no later than **July 28<sup>th</sup>, 2023**.
