HERE ARE SOME SUGGESTIONS FOR YOUR STAY IN SANTIAGO 2023

Arrive early

Make sure to arrive at the venue before the event begins. Generally, the gates will open one to two hours before the competition. Plan your trip!

Wear appropriate clothing

Expect hot and dry weather in October. Also, consider wearing appropriate footwear, as many of the venues are outdoors and may have uneven terrain. Stay hydrated, and remember to apply sunscreen regularly.

Have your ticket ready

Please remember to have your ticket and your ID (identification card or passport) with you when you enter the venue. You'll need a valid ticket, whether it's paid, free, or complimentary, to enter.



Please get ready for the security check

Avoid carrying large bags to the venues. If you're unsure about what you can bring, please refer to the following link for information on prohibited and permitted items to enter the venues.

Stay informed

When you're at the venue, follow the signs to find your way. Pay attention to the signs given by the volunteers, or check the signs located at the venue for guidance. This will give you the necessary information to make the most of your experience.

If you still need help, visit the venue's information desk.



If you attend with minors, please ensure you keep them within your sight at all times. If a minor gets separated from you, please head to the information desk at the respective venue for assistance.

Take care of your belongings

If you happen to lose an item, you can visit the venue's information desk, and they will assist you in the process of retrieving it while the venue is open to spectators.
