Athlete eligibility

Athletes must have signed and submitted the Athlete Eligibility Condition Form and be eligible according to Panam Sports' and the ITTF's eligibility criteria.







Cali 2021 Quotas

The following NOCs were the gold medalists of the individual events who qualified directly for the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games at the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games:

If the athletes who qualified at the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games do not participate in the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games, the quotas will be lost and cannot be transferred to another NOC or athlete.

The athletes who qualified at the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games cannot obtain another quota for their NOC at the singles qualification event; however, another athlete may compete to obtain another quota through the Santiago 2023 qualification system, within the maximum quota per NOC.

The athletes who qualified at the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games will have their participation ensured for the singles event; if Argentina or Cuba do not qualify by teams but qualify an athlete through the Santiago 2021 qualification system for the singles event, the NOCs may comprise a doubles team with the athlete who qualified in Cali.

If Argentina or Cuba qualify for Santiago 2023 through the teams' qualification system, they may include the athletes who qualified in Cali in their official list if they decide to do so, without exceeding the maximum quota per team and guaranteeing the 3 singles quotas.

Wild Cards

- 1. Name of the athlete
- 2. Date of birth
- 3. ITTF ID number







Qualification system

A total of forty-four quotas per gender will be allocated as described below:

	Team Qualification (12 overall)
Quota	Qualification Event
2 teams	Winner and finalist of the 2022 ITTF Pan American Championship
7 teams	The 2 best positioned NOCs on each regional event will obtain two (2) quotas per team (3 athletes per NOC) Each Regional Confederation must identify an existing event that will be used as their qualification event. The quotas are allocated according to the regional quotas table below. "Region quotes"
2 teams	Special qualification event for the NOCs that have not qualified yet
1 team	As host country, Chile has 1 team per gender guaranteed for participation, in case the country has not qualified yet

The athletes who qualify in doubles must be part of the team.

	Singles Qualification (32 overall)
Quota	Qualification Event
24 athletes	Each NOC qualified with a team is entitled to participate with 2 athletes in the singles event. The NOCs must determine who, from among their players, will participate in this event (maximum 2 players by NOC).
6 athletes	Special qualification event for the NOCs that have not qualified a team yet. This event must be held after the team qualification process is finalized. The NOCs may qualify up to 2 athletes per gender in this event.
1 universality	The universality quota will be allocated to the NOC eligible to receive such quota.
1 athlete	Winner at the Cali 2021 Pan American Games in singles.

Confirmation of quota places

The ITTF-Americas and the Pan American Confederation must confirm to Panam Sports and to the NOCs the places that have qualified no later than July 3rd, 2022.

The NOCs will confirm to Panam Sports, the ITTF-Americas and the Pan American Confederation the places they will use before July 7th, 2022.

Reallocation of unused quota places

If necessary, no later than July 10th, 2023, the ITTF-Americas and the Pan American Confederation will reallocate unused quota places to the next best positioned NOC that has not qualified yet in the corresponding event.

The NOCs that receive reallocated quotas must confirm their participation no later than July 14th, 2023.







Qualification for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games

At the Pan American Games Santiago 2023 the gold and silver medal winners in the mixed doubles event will earn direct qualification to the Paris 2024 Olympic Games.
